

Cookies

The cookies used on this website and its sub-domains fall under the categories described below.

You can disable the cookies on the browser at any time. We remind you that blocking cookies might prevent some parts of our webpage from displaying correctly.

Instructions for disabling cookies from your browser

If you use Internet Explorer

In Internet Explorer, click on the "Tools" button, and then click "Internet Options". Click the "Privacy" tab, and then, under "Settings", move the slider to the top to block all cookies or to the bottom to allow all cookies, and then click "OK".

If you use Firefox

Click the Firefox menu icon and choose "Preferences". Select the "Privacy" panel. Set "Firefox will:" to "Use custom settings for history". Uncheck "Accept cookies from sites" to disable cookies. Close the Preferences page. Any changes you've made will automatically be saved.

If you use Safari

From the Safari Browser, click the "Safari" tab and select "Preferences". Click on "Privacy". Click the option "Always block" and then click "OK".

If you use Google Chrome

Select the Chrome menu icon and select "Settings". Near the bottom of the page, select "Show advanced settings". In the "Privacy" section, select "Content settings". Select "Block sites from setting any data". Select "Done".

If you use any other browser, check its preferences to find out how cookies are managed.

Definitions

Cookies are small text files generated by websites that are visited by the user and contain data relating to browsing sessions that may be useful to the website later on. The data allows the website to store important information from page to page and also allows the user's interactions with the website to be analysed.

Cookies are essential for the functioning of the internet and entail a number of advantages for the user's browsing experience; they enhance both the browsing and the usability of the website.

Types of cookies

Based on the characteristics and the use of cookies, we can distinguish between the following types of cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies:** These are cookies which are necessary in order to allow the Toffoletto De Luca Tamajo e Soci website to function correctly and are used to manage the login and access to the website's private functions. These cookies expire at the end of the user's browsing session (closing the browser deletes them).
- **Performance and analytics cookies:** These are cookies that are used in order to collect and analyse website's traffic and use in an anonymous manner. Even without identifying

the user, these cookies enables the website to know whether the same user returns to the website at different times.

These cookies also allow the system to be monitored and improve its performance and usability. Disabling these cookies may be done without any loss in functionality.

▪ **User profiling cookies:** These are permanent cookies that are permanently used in order to identify (both anonymously and otherwise) the preferences of the user and to improve his or her navigation experience. The Toffoletto De Luca Tamajo e Soci website does not use these types of cookies.

Google Analytics

The Toffoletto De Luca Tamajo e Soci website contains certain components sent by Google Analytics, a service provided by Google, Inc. ("Google") that analyses the web traffic. Even in this case, the cookies used are third party cookies which are collected and managed anonymously in order to monitor and improve the performance of the host website (performance cookies).

Google Analytics uses the "cookies" in order to anonymously collect and analyse the information regarding the usage behaviour of the Toffoletto De Luca Tamajo e Soci website (including the IP address of the user). This information is gathered by Google Analytics, which processes them for the purpose of drawing up a report for the operators of the Firm concerning website activity. This website does not use (and does not allow third parties to use) the Google analytics tool to monitor or gather personal ID information. Google does not associate the IP address to any other data held by Google, nor does it try to connect the IP address with the identity of the user. Google may provide this information to third parties if required by the law or if said third parties process the aforementioned information on Google's.
